Be respectful

Be respectful at all times in the Google Classroom. Remote learning follows the same expectations as face-to-face school. Students are expected to be respectful and professional at all times. All aspects of the Student Code of Conduct apply to remote learning, including but not limited to the use of inappropriate language, bullying, etc.



Follow Directions

Be sure to follow the directions that are given for each assignment. Manage your time well so that all assignments are turned in on time.



Monitor your Progress

Review written feedback from your teachers and check your grades regularly. Your teachers will continue to give you feedback and grades just as if you were in school.



Stay on Topic

Your comments and posts should be classroom oriented. This is not the place to discuss things that do not relate to your schoolwork.



Respect Copyright Laws

This means that you shouldn't take information or ideas from someone else and pretend that they're your own.



Ask for Help

Reach out to your teachers for help when you need it. Each of your teachers will provide online "Office Hours" to provide extra help for students who need it. Pay attention to your Google Classroom to find out when your teacher will be available each week so that you can take advantage of their help.
