Administration of Medication by School Personnel:

Prescription Medication

- Parents assume the responsibility for transporting their children's medication to and from school. Parents also assume the responsibility for loss or misuse of medication that is sent to school with their child rather than being brought to the school clinic by the parent.
- Long-term (two weeks or longer) prescription medication may be administered only if the school's Medication Request Form is completed. The medicine must be in a properly labeled prescription container, accompanied by physician's directions and a written request from the parent.
- Short-term (up to two weeks) prescription medication may be administered only if it is in a properly labeled prescription container with the physician's directions and a written request from the parent.

Non-Prescription Medication

- Non-prescription medication is not administered unless it is in a properly labeled container, accompanied by physician's directions and a written request from the parent. The medication must be **exactly** what the accompanying order states. No substitutions or generics will be accepted unless labeled by the pharmacy.
- All medication must be given to the school nurse or a member of the administration.
